

Safe Re-Opening Plan – Prairie City SVRA

BlackSwanMoto has always been focused on safety and take the health and safety of our staff and customers very seriously. In addition to our existing practices for safe training classes, BlackSwanMoto will be implementing these additional practices and guidelines.

Measures to Protect Health

Before training:

All students will be notified of and provided a copy of this plan and enhanced guidelines before the training date.

All students must bring their own cloth facemask that covers their nose and mouth. It is recommended that they bring a spare mask as well.

All attendance is on a pre arraigned (appointment) basis, no "walk-ups" are permitted.

All monetary transactions are handled before the event and online.

BlackSwanMoto students and staff will have their temperature checked upon arrival with a Touchless Forehead Thermometer. Following the CDC's definition of a fever, any students, instructors or staff with a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or above will not be permitted to stay.

Staff with symptoms, those that are not feeling wells or those that know they have been exposed to COVID-19 will be instructed to stay home, follow the CDC guidelines, and consult with their personal health provider.

BlackSwanMoto staff will clean and disinfect the Environmental Training Center (ETC) outdoor seating area hard surfaces and high-touched objects with approved disinfectant. This includes but is not limited to; table, benches, and gate handles.

A hand sanitizer station will be setup in the outdoor covered seating area for student and staff use.

Students and staff will receive a briefing each morning on social distancing and hygiene guidelines. These include: avoid touching eyes, nose, mouth and face; cover any sneeze or cough into your elbow and disinfect hands and elbow immediately after; effective hand hygiene including washing/sanitizing hands for at least 20 seconds regularly.

Students and staff will also be directed that only one person at a time is permitted in the restrooms.

Instructors will remind students of guidelines at each rest break as well.

Signs, if not already present, will be posted at the entrance to the training area and at the ETC outdoor seating area that they should: avoid entering the facility if they have a cough or fever; wear facial coverings, maintain a minimum six-foot distance from one another; and not shake hands or engage in any unnecessary physical contact.

During Training:

Attendance for individual classes will be limited to 10 persons (to include instructors). Black Swan Moto will attempt to conduct classes comprised of individuals from the same family and/or household.

Instructors and students will maintain a minimum six feet separation when at all possible.

Masks will be worn at all times while in the outdoor seating area or when a minimum of six feet separation is not possible.

All students, and staff will be provided written information regarding hand washing and the following is posted that hand washing is mandatory at the following times:

- After using the restroom
- After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- Before, during, and after work shifts
- Before and after work breaks
- After touching frequently touched surfaces

Each student will have a designated parking space for their motorcycle for that will be separated from each other a minimum of 10 feet.
